Intercultural trilateral training course (Cypriot – French – German)

Title: Yesterday and Today's Borders – actuality, history and collective memory

Target group: multipliers, social educators, teachers, volunteers (8 persons per country)

The trainings course will be organised in three phases in 2010 and 2011 (Berlin, Cyprus and Marseille).

The seminars will last for 8-9 days each (ideally with the same participants).

Working languages: Greek, French, German - translation will be provided

Suggested dates:

Berlin: June 18 to June 26, 2010

Cyprus: October 15 to October 23, 2010

Marseille: Spring 2011

Team

1 coordinator/ trainer and 1 translator from each country (Berlin: Ulrike Ramlow, Steffen Ramlow; Marseille: Farah Barakat, Rafik Mousli)

Before each seminar, the international team will prepare the concept and programme in a preparatory meeting. In addition to that, roles and responsibilities in the team will be discussed in the preparatory meeting.

Suggested dates for the preparatory meeting in Berlin May 17 to May 20, 2010

Content:

- Training on intercultural processes and competences
- Work on the impact of borders and walls on the respective societies: How do borders influence our societies? How do they shape the image of the other?
- Exchange and networking (developing follow-up projects)

Methods: small group work, plenary work, exercises, games, inputs and discussions

Tools: Photo, Film, Website,

Tasks of the Cypriot team:

- Active communication with the international team before, during and after the seminars
- Organisation & Preparation of the Cypriot group (finding participants, organising the flights)
- Participating in the preparatory meetings
- Organising the seminar in Cyprus (programme, food and lodging, transportation)

Budget:

- Core funding is granted by the Franco-German Youth Office (www.dfjw.org/english-version)
-food, lodging and programme costs are covered
- Travel expenses are covered up to **322,- Euro** for the flights from Cyprus to Berlin!
- The difference to actual flight costs might be the participation fee for cypriot participants, (same applies for the French and German participants for the seminar in Cyprus)
